

Conceptual Framework




Evaluation Findings - DiD

- **Significant outputs and outcomes**


Impact of the intervention on RSH of Married Adolescent girls

% YMW utilized minimum standard antenatal care


(Registration for antenatal care within 12 weeks, at least 5 antenatal check ups, 2 TT injections & 90 IFA tablets)




Reported prevalence of antenatal complications




Reported prevalence of intra-natal complications




Reported prevalence of postnatal complications




Prevalence of Low Birth Weight (LBW) babies



% YMWs using FP to delay pregnancy & for spacing




% YMW using contraceptives for last 12 months




Girl's Agency - Mobility




Significant increase in mobility after exposure to intervention

Girl's Agency – Decision Making




Significant increase in decision-making ability of adolescent girls at end-line after exposure to Life Skills Education

Social Networking – Participation in a community group




Significant increase in participation of adolescent girls in group activities at end-line after exposure to Life Skills Education

Difference-in-differences analysis –% change in proportion of girls getting married before age 18 years




Net 9.9% significant reduction in proportion of girls getting married before 18 years in study area as compared to control area, after the intervention.

Significant increase in proportion of girls married after 18 of age in 2017 as compared to 2016 & 2015
